#### Ronan Tynan Concert is Sellout

After disapointing sales for the Foundation sponsored Patchogue Theatre shows last fall, sales are back with a vengeance for the February 26 concert by Irish Tenor Ronan Tynan.

The 1169 seats available for the performance were completely sold out by December 21, more than two months before the show. A high percentage of the tickets were purchased as Christmas gifts.

Tickets went on sale Nov. 21, announced by an ad in the Brookhaven edition of Newsday. The only additional advertising was a letter sent to each person who bought tickets for last February's performance. A high percentage of those purchasers bought again. There was one block purchase of 40 seats, purchased by a financial services firm, and another block purchase of 30.

Last year's show was also a sellout, but less quickly and with additional advertising.

The show is co-sponsored by the Bay Shore Hibernians with their Hibernian Festival Singers also on the bill, and they will split the profit with the Foundation.



#### **New Fire Island Superintendent**



A new superintendent takes over in early February at Fire Island National Seashore. He's Michael T. (Mike) Reynolds who moves to Patchogue from Yosemite National Park in California where he is chief of planning. Reynolds, who is 41, comes from a national park background. His father, John Reynolds, retired as director of the Parks Service Pacific West region and is now a senior fellow at the National Parks Foundation. His

grandfather was a forest ranger at Yellowstone and his mother's family ran concessions at Yosemite for decades.

Reynolds grew up near San Francisco and earned a bachelor's degree in environmental studies from the University of California at Santa Barbara in 1985. His subsequent National Parks assignments have been in Denver, at Cape Cod, at Mojave National Preserve in California, and, after two years in Washington at the Bureau of Land Management, at Yosemite.

Reynolds is married to Landscape Architect Amy Schneckenburger, also a Parks Service employee. They have an 11 month old daughter Grace Ann.

Barry Sullivan, who became acting Superintendent after the death of Dave Spirites last April, is leaving Patchogue to become the Superintendent at Gateway National Recreation Area in New York.



#### **East Main Street Facades**

A significant amount of money remains available for grants to offset the cost of facade improvements at businesses on East Main Street east of the Patchogue Village line.

The reimbursement rate has been increased for the period between Jan. 1, 2005 and June 30, 2005. During that period, qualifying businesses can collect 75% reimbursement, up from the normal 50%.

A number of conditions apply, but this grant money can amount to real help for facade projects in the East Main Street area. The money comes from a \$50,000 grant by Brookhaven Town and \$10,000 from North Fork bank.

## First Graduation: Two Women Set Free

The Lighthouse Mission's Hannah House Women's Life Center held their First Graduation ceremony on December 18, 2004 in Patchogue. The goal of the 12-18 month program is to have the women's broken lives healed and transformed so they can return home as productive members of society and responsible parents and citizens.

One graduate, who had been on the street for nine years, also renewed her marriage vows in a ceremony following the graduation. She has now returned home with her husband and two children to be a wife and mother once again.

Since 1992 Lighthouse Mission has been feeding the hungry and helping families in need through its base in Patchogue as well as through street outreaches in six Long Island towns. They provide food, clothing and other assistance to families in need as well as referral services.
