Foundation Shows at the Patchogue Theatre

The Greater Patchogue Foundation, continuing its efforts to bring world class entertainment to the Patchogue Theatre will present three shows this fall.

These shows are a cooperative effort between the foundation and the theatre. The foundation is financing the costs of the acts and the advertising and the theatre will provide the space and all of the production and sell the tickets.

Chuck Mangione, a two time Grammy Award winner and a trumpet playing jazz icon for more than 40 years, will be at the theatre Saturday night, Sept. 25, at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$45 for orchestra seats and \$35 in the balcony.

On Saturday, Oct. 9 at 8 p.m. it will be another legendary jazz figure—percussionist Bill Cobham. Cobham has won international acclaim for more than 30 years for his matchless, dazzling, ambidextrous skills as a drummer. He will perform with the *Culture Mix* band. All tickets are \$35.
