Workforce Work Begins

Existing buildings began to tumble last week to make way for Copper Beach Village, 80 condominium units, being built in a workforce housing project by Pulte Homes in cooperation with the village of Patchogue, Suffolk County, and The Long Island Housing Partnership. Half of the units will be offered in a lottery at below market rates—an estimated \$175,000 or \$240,000 depending on family income. Half of those will be reserved for Patchogue residents. The other 40 units will be sold at the market rate—\$375,000. The units are expected to be ready for occupany by the end of the year.

A family of four with income of about \$71,000 would qualify for the lowest cost units. Families of four with income of about \$107,000 would qualify for the \$240,000 workforce units.

Customers with Disabilities

Making it possible for customers with disabilities to purchase your goods and services is an important part of complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act. This article (adapted from the ADA website) focuses on alternate access when removing barriers in older buildings is not readilbly achievable.

When a barrier prevents access to a business's goods or services and removing it is not "feadily achievable", the ADA expects businesses to offer their goods and services to people with disabilities in other ways that are "feadily achievable."

Examples

A restaurant, small store, dry cleaner, or similar business located on a narrow sidewalk with a flight of steps up or down to its entrance may be unable to install a ramp or a lift because of cost or site constraints. They can make their goods and services available to a customer with a disability by providing curb-side service or home delivery.

An accountant, an attorney, or an insurance agent whose office is inaccessible can arrange to meet with a client at some other convenient location, such as a public library or the client's home.

A retailer can assist a customer by retrieving merchandise from an inaccessible part of the store.

You may not charge people with disabilities higher prices to cover the cost of providing service in an alternative way. For example, a restaurant may not charge a person who uses a wheelchair extra for home delivery when it is provided as the alternative to barrier removal.

Businesses that provide curb-side service should install a buzzer or bell so the customer can signal for service.

When barrier removal is not readily achievable, the ADA expects

businesses to offer their goods and services to people with disabilities in other ways that are readily achievable.

Businesses may not charge people with disabilities higher prices to cover the costs of providing service in other ways.

Property Taxes—Is There Another Way?

Suffolk County property owners send \$2.8 billion dollars a year in property taxes to the county's 70 school districts and a Suffolk commission has been charged with finding possible alternative revenue sources to relieve the residental tax burden.

The Home Owners Tax
Commission is to report to the
Suffolk County Legislature in
September. It held the first of three
public hearings in Hauppague on
May 23. There were 26 speakers, and
while most of them emphasized
their desire to reduce spending, 10
were willing to consider an income
tax, while only three suggested
income tax reservations. Others suggested a sales tax, tax on land only,
casinos, a lottery, and (jokingly I
think) legalized prostitution.

Suffolk Legislature Presiding
Officer William Lindsey, who chairs
the commission said all of those elements, except prostitution, were
being considered. He said an inheritence tax has also been discussed.

Those who urged income tax caution worried that school districts would simply get more money to spend, and replacing the property tax would only shift the tax burden and disrupt the system. One speaker also worried that a switch to an income tax would eliminate local budget votes. Two speakers liked New York City's approach which uses a combination of property, sales, and income tax.
