Wal-Mart Gets A Hearing

The proposed 120,000 square foot Wal-Mart store at Hospital Rd. and the North Sunrise Highway Service Rd. in East Patchogue was the subject of a May 28 public hearing before the Brookhaven Town Board. About 300 people attended, many carrying signs expressing either opposition or support for the project.

The issue before the board is whether previous re-zoning decisions that resulted in the present 15 acres of business zoned property should be rescinded. If so, the site would lose 3 and a half acres of business zoning. The property is part of an original 105 acre site owned by La Bonne Vie Associates, which built apartments on the northern portion and wants to sell the remainder to Wal-Mart.

Many of the projects supporters are La Bonne Vie residents who would like to see nearby shopping but opponents, including the Greater Patchogue Chamber of Commerce, point to safety issues including the already inadequate Hospital Road Bridge as well as a threat to the small business character of our downtowns.

The board extended the public comment period without setting a new date. It meets next on June 9. When Supervisor Mark Lesko asked for a show of hands he said opponents seemed to outnumber proponents 2-1.

Village Approvals Fpr TRITEC Work Begins Soon



The first phase of work on the \$130 million TRITEC Main Street development, a new facade for the Wedgewood Building, is expected to get underway soon. A bigger phase, demolition of the old Swezey's building on the Four Corners, and construction of a five story hotel plus 154

residential units is expected to start in the fall. The rest of the project is to follow in stages over the next couple of years for a total of 240 apartments and 28,000 square feet of retail space.

The project got the green light in May with its required Patchogue Village approvals.
