### Nancy Leaves The Crab Shack

Nancy and Bruce sold their business to the neighboring Lombardi's and the Village agreed to transfer the lease on the municipal owned property. Now called "The Crabby Shack at Mascot Dock", the business opened, with a similar menu, on Memorial Day weekend. It's not clear yet what the schedule will be. It was open on Tues., June 1, but the attendant said the schedule had not yet been decided.

The Village is also tackling parking problems in the area. It has voted to reduce and restrict parking along South Ocean as well as on Smith Street and Maiden Lane. There have been resident complaints as well as Fire Department concerns for passage of emergency vehicles.
