Owner Jay Lin told the board that the restaurant would be open for dinner from 5 to 10 (midnight on weekends) and also for lunch, Mon-Sat.

Plans submitted to the board show a total of 119 seats including 69 around eight hibachi tables.

There is also a sushi bar and a small cocktail bar.
