

They used to be called traffic circles, and, according to a website devoted to their modern version— *Modern Roundabouts* (roundabouts.kittelson.com)

they have been part of the U.S. transportation system since 1905 when Columbus Circle opened in New York City. There are two familiar local versions in Riverhead.

Such circles fell out of favor in the mid 1950's because of accident and congestion problems. The modern roundabout was developed in the United Kingdom in the 1960's. These

modern versions are significantly different in design and operation, and are being considered by transportation officials, including those in New York for, among other things, their aesthetic and traffic calming advantages.
