The elegantly appointed venue will be both a restaurant and a catering facility. The downstairs Ballroom catering room seats 270 and there are also two catering rooms upstairs. In addition, the family is constructing a large glass enclosed room on the bayside patio that will be used for catering and regular dining.

Also, watch Main Street for the coming Public House 49. The 200 seat restaurant will use the storefront just west of the theatre formally occupied by Hazy Moon together with the adjacent former bakery.
