which also owns a ShopRite in Hauppauge.

The Jansons held a preview party on Thursday night, Oct. 27, and opened for business the next morning. The 71,000 square foot store is larger than the one in Hauppauge. It includes a robotic fork lift to trundle goods for its more than \$2

million inventory from the loading dock on the west end down a 350 foot corridor.

The store, which



has featured a jammed parking lot, is open Monday-Saturday from 6:00 a.m. until midnight. Sunday hours are 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Ever since Raymour & Flannigan moved into the west end of the old Home Depot building at Sunrise Highway and Rt. 112, there has been much anticipation for the supermarket promised for the east end. It's a ShopRite, owned by the Janson family
