Hundreds of visitors got a close preview look at the new \$20.5 million YMCA on West Main Street as Ribbon Cutting Ceremonies were held Aug. 27. The building will open its doors for good at 5 AM, Sept. 7.

The state of the art 54,000 square foot facility includes 7 child care classrooms, a child watch room, 25 yard pool, gymnasium and running track, two story rock climbing wall, a wellness/fitness center, teen center with computer lab, large multi purpose space and an outdoor roof deck.
